

Navarino's technology supports "K" Line in **Northern Lights EU Decarbonisation Project**



"K" Line Energy Shipping (UK) Ltd, based in London, manages a fleet of 10 vessels operating worldwide. Their vessels will be taking part in the Northen Lights project, which transports and delivers CO2 to special storage facilities in Norway in order to help the mitigation of industrial emissions that cannot be avoided, and to accelerate the decarbonisation of European industry.

In order to help prepare their ships for this project, "K" Line have recently chosen to enhance the connectivity capabilities of their fleet with Navarino. The company will be deploying 2 Starlinks per vessel, for crew welfare usage and for business use. The two terminals will be managed and controlled using Navarino's Infinity solution


