## Connecting the Lighthouses of Greece

As part of its "Connecting Greece with the Future" program, Navarino is launching a collaboration with the Hellenic Lighthouse Service to provide free Starlink systems to some of the most important lighthouses in Greece.

In mid-October, Tasos Barbas, Head of Corporate Responsibility at Navarino, and the company's "Green Ambassador," Akis Temperidis, visited the Lighthouse Service headquarters in Piraeus, where they met with the Director of Lighthouses, Captain Stathis Pappis.
