In early September, Greece experienced severe weather conditions that caused significant damage, particularly in the central region of Thessalia. Heavy rainfall resulted in the flooding of the main rivers and the bursting of nearby dams. As a result, over 10 villages had to be evacuated, leaving many people displaced from their homes, with some unable to return.

Navarino responded to this crisis on two fronts. Firstly, we contacted local crisis managers and mobilized our personnel to gather specific food and cleaning products.

Along with our company's contribution, our staff were able to put together five pallets of supplies, which were promptly sent to local distributors for distribution.

Secondly, recognizing the medical needs of the predominantly elderly population affected by the flooding, we decided to donate a state-of-the-art mobile cardiograph to the local Health Centre.

Continuing with our Navarino UK - Automated External Defibrillator (AED) installment program, we visited the Greek Embassy in London during the summer to express our intention of installing an automatic AED system.

The purpose of this system is to be prepared for any unforeseen incidents that may occur within the embassy premises, as it receives a high number of daily visitors.

Our team of experts from the UK visited the embassy to install the system and conducted a three-hour seminar for 10 members of their staff on how to use it and life-saving techniques.

Navarino, recently took a significant step towards nurturing the next generation of tech enthusiasts. The company proudly sponsored a school hackathon competition at St Catherines School in Athens, aimed at fostering IT skills and cultivating a passion for technology among students.

With several schools participating, and around 200 students taking part, the focus of the hackathon was on 'greener shipping,' aligning with Navarino's commitment to sustainable solutions within the maritime industry. Students were tasked with designing robotics solutions that contribute to the advancement of environmentally-friendly shipping practices.
